Riding along the old roads of Himeji Castle Town

Nozato Kaido, which once served as the gateway to Himeji. And Senba district along the Saigoku Kaido road that runs through the Himeji Castle town. Still retain many traces of history and a charming, nostalgic atmosphere. Located in the heart of Himeji Castle town, this historic route is a must-visit for those seeking to immerse themselves in the culture and heritage of the area.

You will ride an electric bicycle through narrow roads that are difficult to drive on.

This 3 hour tour will make you fall in love with Himeji even more, and is the perfect addition before or after sightseeing at Himeji Castle.

SHISO

Cycle through the naturally rich Shiso region to the legendary home of sake, and enjoy a healthy fermented lunch at a sake brewery.

Ichinomiya was once an important area for the development of Harima Province, and records of Japan's oldest sake brewing can be found in ancient historical texts. We will ride through Tunnel of bare excavation and tranquil backroads to the birthplace of fermentation. At Yamazaki Sake Brewery Street, where several sake breweries still remain, you will enjoy a healthy fermented food lunch.

Lunch included

What is included in the price: Guide fee, e-bike, helmet, bicycle liability insurance, travel Accident Insurance, EkiSoba(noodle) ticket
Recommended age: 13 years old and over (people over 150cm tall who can ride a bicycle alone)

Clothing: We recommended that you wear clothes that is easy to move in and long pants which can be tightened at the bottom (to prevent accidents caused by gear).

Belongings: Please bring rain gear, cold weather clothing, gloves, towels, drinks, etc. as needed. A backpack is convenient for carrying your belongings.

Note: Due to weather conditions or other factors, we may contact you to cancel the tour after your reservation has been confirmed.

The bicycles we use are recommended by the manufacturer for people with a height of 150cm or more.

For safety reasons, we will not allow anyone under 150cm tall to ride, even if they are within the recommended age range.

Use by minors alone requires parental consent.
